
#### EEIA/UFI/EMECA SURVEY ON INVESTMENTS INTO EXHIBITION INFRASTRUCTURE IN EUROPE

This survey describes recent and upcoming investments into European exhibition venues

...It is based on a questionnaire sent to all venues in Europe, UFI European Members and Members of EMECA

...With 32 participanting venues from 16 European countries it covers the current European trends

...The owner structure of participants is more private than public or a mix of public/private

#### AIM AND SET UP OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE

#### AIM:

> Get a clearer picture about the investment situation of exhibition venues in Europe

#### **SET UP:**

- > Division between investments into refurbishments and expansion of fair grounds
- > Find out priority areas
- > Find out most challenging areas
- All areas relate to infrastructure, e.g. digitization could mean cable channels, smart buildings, digital entrance solutions, etc.
- > Ask about the way investments are financed
- > Questions as to the past and today/future
- > 18 questions
- > Sent out via UFI and EMECA to all European Venue Members in September 2016
- > 32 answers received



#### EEIA/UFI/EMECA SURVEY ON INVESTMENTS INTO EXHIBITION INFRASTRUCTURE IN EUROPE

#### **KEY FINDINGS (1/2)**

- > No new major venue developments are planned in Europe
- > Instead, investments go into quality of existing spaces and some increases of exhibition space
- > Investments in the past five years: EUR 3,348 billion
- > Investments in the next five years: EUR 1,791 billion
- > Total investments within 10 years: EUR 5,139 billion
- Investments into refurbishment were higher in the past than they will be in the future, but all participating venues will invest in the future
- > Number of venues will grow in the following size segments: 25,001-100,000 sqm and over 250,000 sqm




#### EEIA/UFI/EMECA Survey on Investments into Exhibition Infrastructure in Europe

#### **KEY FINDINGS (2/2)**

- > Clear change in area of investment from building/venue to digitization
  - > past: energy efficiency, design and architecture leading
  - > future: digitization by far leading
- > Important area
  - > today: digitization, energy efficiency and security leading
  - > in 5 years: digitization increased, energy efficiency and sustainability security still relatively important
- > Most challenging
  - > today: by far digitization, second security
  - > future: digitization even more challenging
- > 75 % financing by cash flow or bank loan or combination of both




Q2/Q5: How much have you invested/will you invest into refurbishing/modernising (excluding maintenance) your venue infrastructure in...






# Q3/Q6: Investments in which area











Q4/Q7: How much have you invested/will you invest into the expansion of indoor exhibition space of your venue infrastructure in...






## Q8/9: What is the most important area for you...






## Q8/9: What is the most important area for you...

Digitization leading






## Q10/11: What is the most challenging area for you...






## Q10/11: What is the most challenging area for you...

Digitization leading








